Kids who were plugged into a fellowship:

Fellowship most often means a local church. Because the body of Christ spans multiple generations, a fellowship will sustain them through life -- in a special way beyond YFC.

New believing kids who began 3Story® relationships with peers:

We love when kids who come to Christ ultimately begin to catch a vision for their lost friends. These Young Leaders are the future and a proven part of our growth strategy!

Kids engaged in discipleship:

When kids come to Christ, we engage them in an ongoing discipleship relationship to help them learn how to follow Jesus faithfully.

Kids who came to Christ:

We believe that if we're faithful to put leaders in authentic, Christ-sharing reltationships with lost kids, the Holy Spirit will do what only He can do.

Kids in coversations with a leader:

Leaders and kids initiate conversations with each other throughout the year. Conversations help leaders identify lost kids and create opportunites to share Christ.

Lost kids in authentic Christ-sharing relationships:

Our leaders initiate and sustain new 3Story® relationships through the year. Our most important measurement: leaders with lost kids.

A concrete measure of the total number of kids connected to YFC ministry.

Rebalance Mental Health Program

Mental health remains one of the most pressing challenges facing today's youth. Rebalance creates space for young people to "Heal and Belong so they can Hear and Believe." The program prioritizes mental, emotional, and spiritual wellbeing, especially for those navigating trauma or adversity. This intentional progression—from healing and belonging to hearing and believing—is foundational to our YFC mission of sharing the Good News of Jesus in a holistic and transformative way.

As of April 2025, 12 YFC chapters are actively participating in the Rebalance pilot program. Program data from these chapters was collected and reviewed in May 2025. In the recent report prepared by the Social Research Lab (SRL) of the University of Northern Colorado, the following findings were noted among others:

PARTICIPANTS AGREED THAT THE REBALANCE PROGRAM HAS

91%

taught them that they are in control of their own thoughts and actions

89%

provided them a trusted adult in their life, that they previously did not have

91%

taught them how their actions may affect others, and how to think through their actions





"We realized that trying to control behavior wasn't working and honestly, it was exhausting. What kids needed wasn't more rules or consequences; they needed tools. Tools for calming their bodies, managing stress, and feeling safe enough to open up. That's where Rebalance became so transformative. Instead of us reacting to behavior, we started teaching kids how to regulate emotions through breathing, and finding calm. When kids learned these practices, it not only reduced conflict, but it opened their hearts. Because when they feel safe, they can finally hear us and more importantly, they can hear about Jesus. These calming practices may look simple, but they're powerful. Breathing and pausing creates space for kids to feel safe. And when we use them in front of kids, they learn without us even saying a word. Children mirror what we model. When mentors, grandparents, parents, or leaders self-regulate, kids learn how to self-regulate. This is discipleship. We show them Jesus' peace through our examples not our words."

> Calm adults open the door to calm kids, and calm kids can hear God's voice.

What's Next?

Following data analysis, we anticipate one or more of the following strategic steps:

- **Expanded Piloting:** Additional chapters may be invited to join the pilot in order to validate initial findings and broaden the data set.
- Scaling the Program: Early results are promising, and our goal is to continue scaling Rebalance across the broader YFC movement. This includes building infrastructure to support both existing pilot chapters and the onboarding of new ones, along with increased staffing and program resources.
- Executive Director Training & Support: We've identified the overall health of chapter leadership as a key factor in program success. In response, we will introduce focused training for Executive Directors, emphasizing entrepreneurial leadership, strategic resourcing, and grant acquisition. This initiative will empower leaders to secure sustainable funding beyond traditional donations.
